This is technical work involving project coordination and supervisory duties in the Construction Section. The Supervisor is responsible for implementing Parks construction projects and structural maintenance programs. Working with a dedicated crew of trades/landscape professionals and contractors, the Supervisor oversees installation and maintenance of a wide range of assets including playgrounds, trails, parking lots, sports courts, drainage, bridges, stairs, buildings, landscaping, furniture and signage.

Several combinations of education/experience meet the position requirements: 1) a degree or diploma in a field related to Parks Construction from a recognized post-secondary institution; or 2) Certificate of Apprenticeship or Trades Qualification Certificate in Carpentry or other landscape construction related trade; or 3) completion of technical training/courses supplemented by extensive, comprehensive experience in landscape construction, project management, playground installation, structural maintenance, and/or carpentry.

This should be supplemented by five years of progressive experience in Construction; possession of, or the ability to obtain, a Certified Playground Inspector Certificate; experience in project management, budgeting, cost estimating and scheduling; supervisory skills training and a minimum of one year supervisory experience in Construction; possession of, or ability to obtain, a valid BC Pesticide Applicator Certificate and possession of a valid Class 5 Driver's License and a personal vehicle available for use as and when required.
