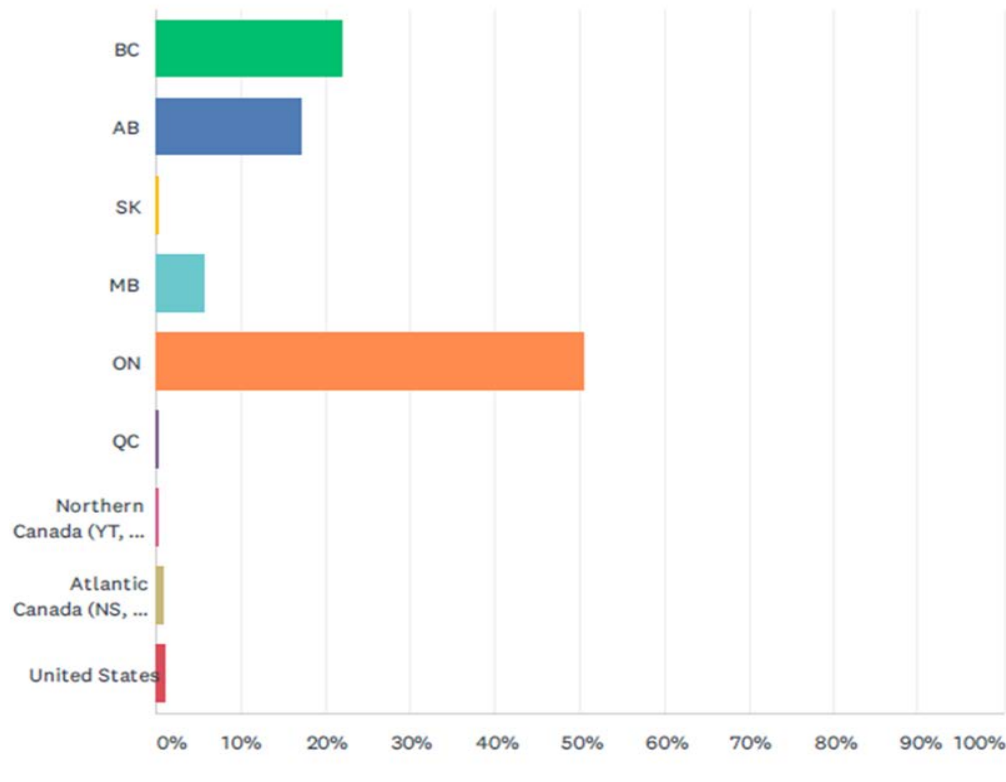


COVID-19 Survey Summary BC Residents – Second Check in: June 2020

Q1 PRIMARY RESIDENCE

Answered: 590 Skipped: 0



Who answered the survey?

- 129 respondents whose primary residence is in BC
- 22% are not registered (associates, interns, affiliates, students, etc.)
- 50% work in landscape architecture offices (18% in solo LA offices); 27% in government, 14% in multidisciplinary firms, 9% in other office types

How has work changed with COVID-19?

- 53% are working in a different location (from home, alternate office, etc.)
- 2% have been permanently laid off
- Respondents reported a broad range of changes to work volume compared to before COVID-19, averaging slightly higher than normal work volume (9% increase in work volume)

What would BC residents like to see from their Associations?

- Top priority: more online professional educational events
 - Wednesday Webinar and Friday File opportunities are appreciated
- Networking opportunities
 - Sharing information and resources; brainstorming best practices and future for landscape architecture
 - Specific inclusive networking for newcomers to the BCSLA
- Support and advocacy:
 - Support for LA candidates
 - Advocacy for equity, racial justice and reconciliation within the profession
- Mixed opinions on COVID-19-related communications and events
 - Want: best practices during COVID-19, information summaries relevant to landscape architecture
 - Do not want: general COVID-19 information that is available on government websites

What other questions do BC respondents have?

- Actionable requests regarding diversity and equity
- Will there be additional board interviews for certification? Will these be in person or virtual video conference format?

Comments on the survey:

- Confusion about how to rank priorities question – please specify whether 1 or 5 is the top priority
- Regarding changes to work location, please add an option for split time between home and the office
