

BCSLA PRE-INTERN APPLICATION

NOTE: The information below applies to British Columbia only. Entry standards vary from one jurisdiction to another.

An individual may apply for recognition as a Pre-intern Associate of the Society who,

- i. has been employed for less than six (6) years in the field of Landscape Architecture; or
- *ii.* has a degree in an allied discipline; or
- *iii.* has work experience in a related field.

Upon acceptance by the Board and payment of all fees when due, such individuals are entitled to use the designation "BCSLA Pre-Intern" and receive all general communications of the Society, attend general meetings as a non-voting Associate, attend continuing education programs and sessions at BCSLA rates, and benefit from the information resources of the Society. All BCSLA Associates are bound by the Principles and Standards of the Society, and the Bylaws as applicable, which can be viewed at <u>www.bcsla.org/profession/bylaws-standards</u>. Please read The Road to Registration at <u>www.bcsla.org/education/education-0</u> before applying.

The title "Landscape Architect" is regulated in BC in order that members of collateral professions, the construction industry, government, and the general public are assured that an individual has completed an accredited professional degree, followed by documented experience in a range of practice areas, and has met the requirements set out in professional exams. In BC, the Use of Title is governed by the Architects (Landscape) Act:

- 1) A person who is a member in good standing of the Society is entitled to use the designation "Landscape Architect."
- 2) A person who is not a member in good standing of the Society must not assume or use that designation in any manner or represent that the person is entitled to do so.

For candidates with degrees and/or work experience outside the field of Landscape Architecture, a reduction to the sixyear requirement may be applied as listed below:

Note #1: The amount of the reduction can be combined accordingly.

Note #2: It is up to the discretion of the Credentials Committee to determine the quality and relevancy of the degrees and experience earned in their recommendation of the amount of the reduction applied.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

- 1. Please review this material carefully. Applications are reviewed monthly except for August and December. All applications are reviewed by the BCSLA Credentials Committee which makes recommendations to the Board of Directors who have the final approval at their monthly meeting (typically the fourth Tuesday of the month).
- 2. Complete the application in full. Incomplete applications will delay application processing.
- 3. Required documentation. Proof of academic qualifications:
 - a. Academic record transcript (original <u>or</u> certified copy sent directly to BCSLA from the learning institution). The transcript will confirm successful completion of a Bachelor or Masters program in Landscape Architecture at an accredited university, or other degree in an allied discipline <u>and</u>
 - b. Academic degree, certificate, or diploma (copy)

For internationally trained candidates only:

You must have your credentials evaluated by the International Credentials Evaluation Services (ICES) or World Evaluation Service (WES) and have your evaluation report sent directly from ICES or WES to the BCSLA office. For more information, please visit <u>www.bcsla.org/licensure/licensure</u>.

- 1. Attach a current resume in chronological order starting with your most recent employer.
- 2. Submit your completed application form and all required documentation by email to <u>office@bcsla.org</u>, or by regular mail to the BCSLA office.
- 3. Submit application of \$52.50 to the BCSLA. Electronic Funds Transfers (EFT) can be sent to <u>admin@bcsla.org</u> and cheques can be addressed to "BCSLA."
- 4. Applicants who are not accepted for BCSLA Pre-intern status will be advised in writing of reasons for deferment and the next step in the Admission Process.
- 5. Applicants who are accepted for BCSLA Pre-intern Associate status will be notified in writing and will be advised to begin the Admission Program.
