Calling all artists, doodlers, and sketchers! The BCSLA is seeking sketches for the Friday File's weekly *Growing Medium* feature. Drawings should adhere to the following submission guidelines:

- Subject should be a single stand-alone tree; any kind will do: realistic, cartoony, minimalistic, detailed, retro, quasi-futuristic, native, exotic, real, or imagined, etc.
- Any drawing type is acceptable, but a file must be submitted digitally
- File format should be PNG or JPG
- Drawings may be black and white or colour (set to RGB colour profile/mode)
- Images should be 1MB in size and 564px wide maximum
- Drawings should not include any text (signature/initials are acceptable)
- With your submission, include your name, a title for the piece, and medium used – refer to the above example

Submissions should be emailed to [kfraser1@richmond.ca](mailto:kfraser1@richmond.ca). Drawings meeting the above criteria will be selected for inclusion in the Friday File. All submissions will be archived, and the BCSLA reserves the right to their future use in BCSLA publications, with credit assigned. We look forward to receiving your sketches!
