1. Name of Project.
2. Name of Firm / Organization of Record, and optionally the name of individual Landscape Architect(s).
3. Date of Completion (and demolition if applicable - this site provides a venue for spaces lost to redevelopment to "live" and be remembered).
4. Street Address.
5. 80-100 words describing significance of the project and the role of the landscape architect.
6. Two or more digital photos (ideally 1200 x 1600 pixels). If file sizes exceed 8 MB, please upload to an ftp site and provide a link.

- A. Obtain approval from the client and other professionals involved in the design as appropriate, before submitting it to the Sitelines Web Atlas.
- B. Are prepared to provide a full list of the project team members upon request.
