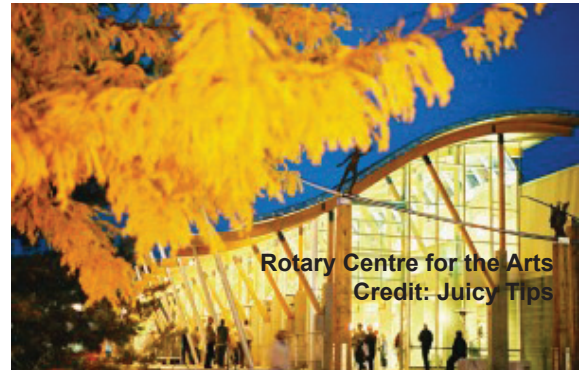

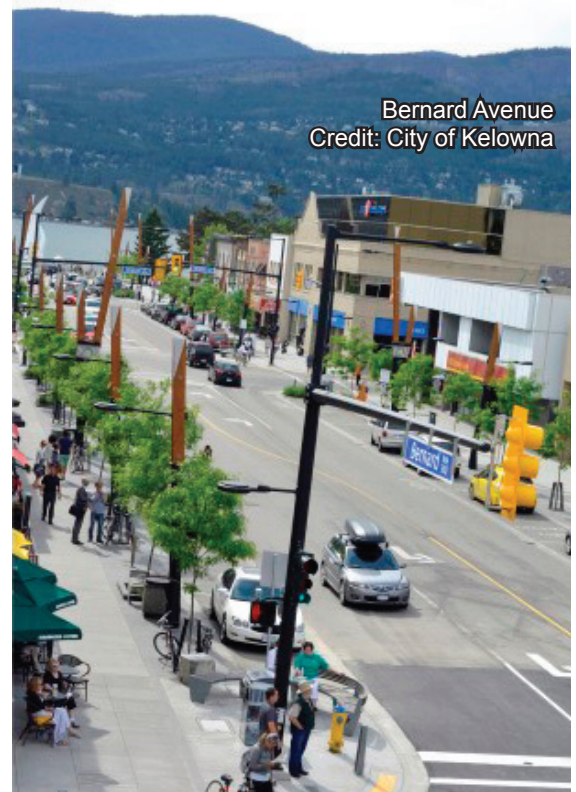

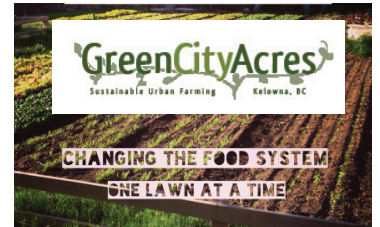
Green City Acres Tour, 862 Lawrence Avenue, Kelowna, BC.....3:00 pm-4:00 pm
